Many monarchs choose a regal name (as popes do) that is different from their birth name such as Charles' godfather George VI who had been christened Albert Fredrick Aurther George and went by the name Bertie for most of his life.

King Charles knows how to play the cello he also know piano and trumpet.

He was the longest serving heir apparent in British history. He was the first royal baby to be born at Buckingham Palace in 20 century. He was the first British royal to earn his degree- studying archaeology, anthropology and history to earn a Bachelor of the arts.

Charles III is King of the United Kingdom and 14 other Commonwealth realms. He acceded to the throne on 8 September 2022 upon the death of his mother, Elizabeth II. He was the longest-serving heir apparent in British history and, at the age of 73, is the oldest person to ascend the British throne.

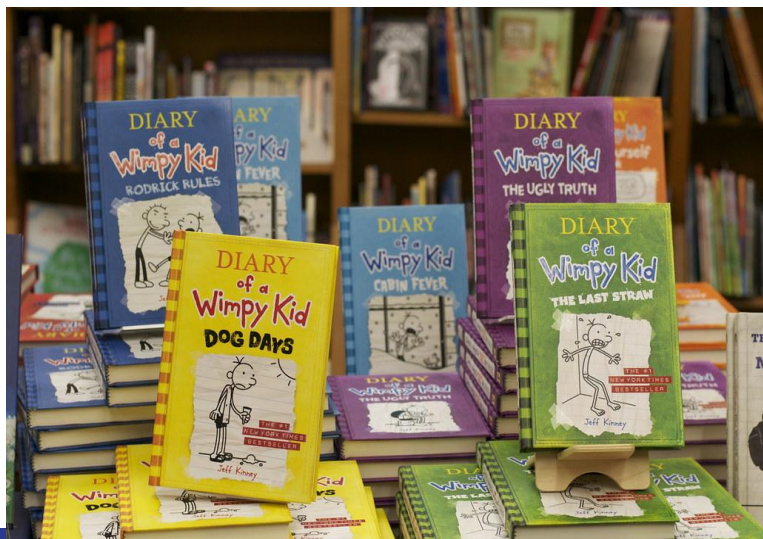

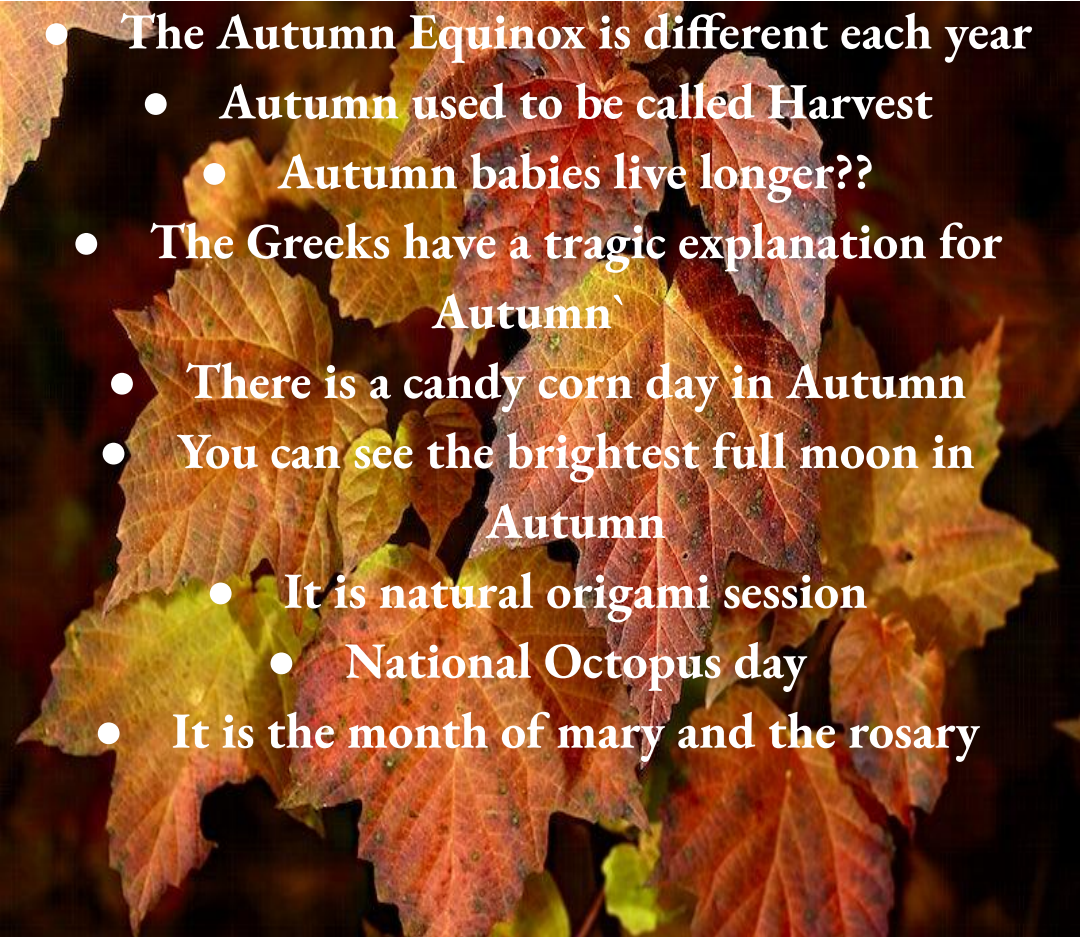
