The show was great fun. Everyone who took part were congratulated for their talents and for their courage of displaying their talents for the whole school.

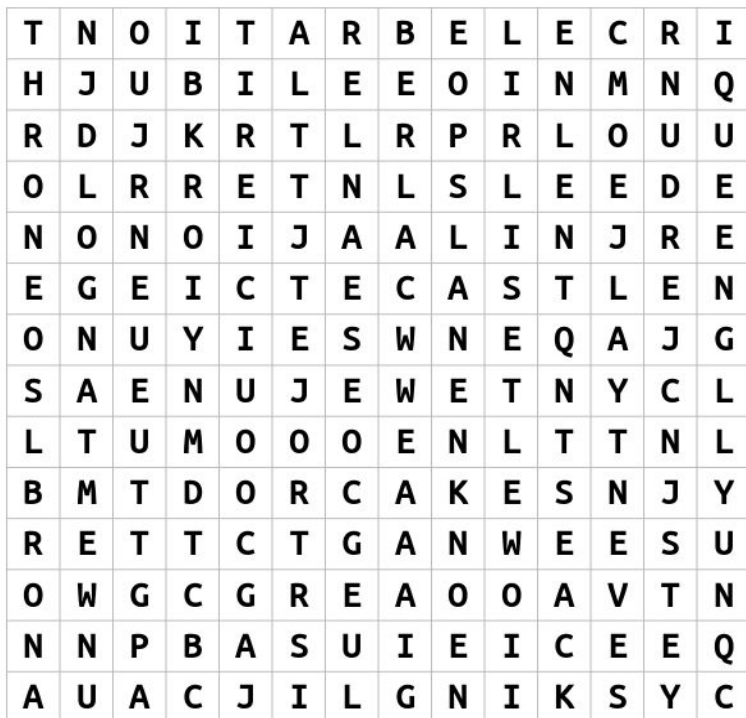

# Victoria Sponge Cake!

## Method

Heat oven to 190C/fan 170C/gas 5. Butter 2 20cm cake tins and line with non-stick baking paper.

In a large bowl, beat 200g caster sugar, 200g softened butter, 4 beaten eggs, 200g self-raising flour, 1 tsp baking powder and 2 tbsp milk together into a smooth, soft batter.

Divide the mixture between the tins, smooth the surface with a spatula or the back of a spoon.

Bake for about 20 mins until golden brown and cake springs back when pressed.

Turn onto a cooling rack and leave to cool completely.

To make the filling, beat 100g softened butter until smooth and creamy, then gradually beat 140g sifted icing sugar and drop of vanilla extract.

Spread the buttercream over the bottom of one of the sponges. Top it with 170g strawberry jam and sandwich the second sponge on top.

Dust with a little icing sugar before serving. Keep in an airtight container.

## Ingredients

220g caster sugar  
200g softened butter  
4 eggs, beaten  
200g self-raising flour  
1 tsp baking powder  
2 tbsp milk

## For Filling

100g butter, softened  
140g icing sugar, sifted  
A drop of vanilla extract (optional)  
170g strawberry jam  
Icing sugar to decorate

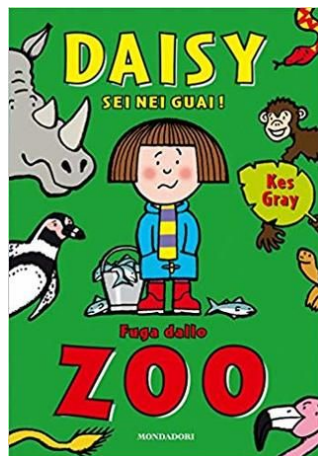

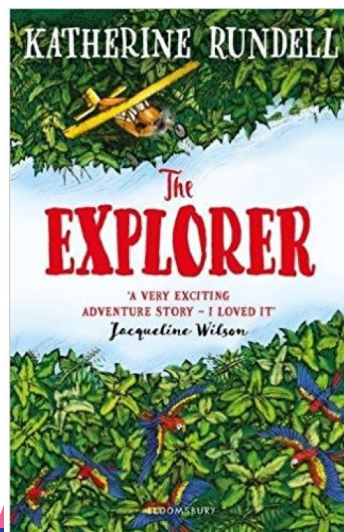
