Ocean conservation.

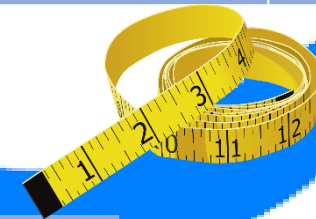
