English

Way Home: Provides opportunities for emotional responses to literature and how to evoke these emotions in their own writing and allows opportunities to develop strong themes within their narratives.

Street Child: Supports children's learning of the Victorian era whilst also giving opportunities to explore the techniques the author uses and write in a similar style.

Maths

Short multiplication and division: multiplying any two or three digit numbers by a single digit number using a range of methods Pupils will also learn to divide three digit numbers by the same methods.

Area and scaling: Pupils will understand what area is and will learn different strategies to calculate the area different shapes including complex compound shapes.

Earth and Space: Become experts on the Earth, Sun, Moon, and how their positioning and movement impacts time zones and seasons in addition to exploring other planets in our solar system.
