Science

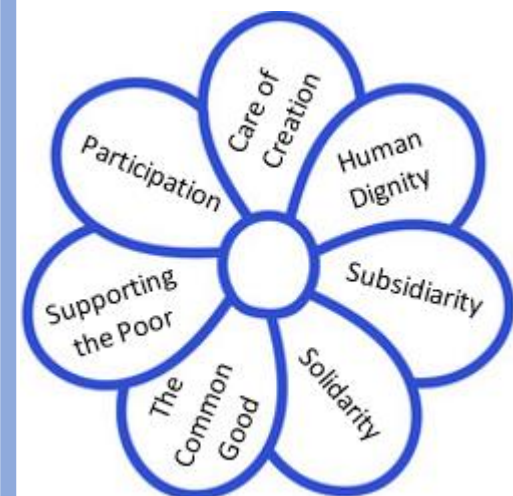
Light & Electricity
