

Music

Layers and rhythms in musical compositions.

Musical Styles - We will be looking at a range of different styles in world music and will aim to recreate them in the classroom.

Art and DT

Famous Artists

Children will explore the work of Henri Rousseau and Frank Warren.

Puppets

We will be designing, making and evaluating hand puppets.

Where do I live?

We will be exploring the countries that make up the UK. We will look at major towns, rivers and customs.

Children will be developing their hand- eye co-ordination to improve sending and receiving techniques. They will be focussing on spatial awareness to develop sequences - including balances and different ways of travelling.

English

Children will continue to focus on learning to apply their phonic knowledge in daily phonic lessons. We will follow the Read Write, Inc. phonic programme.

We will also be exploring the poetry of Shirley Hughes and a fiction picture book by David Lucas. The children will be asked to write for a range of purposes. Cursive handwriting will be encouraged and taught in the classroom.

Maths

Place value

We will be exploring the value of each digit in a two-digit number and adding two two digit numbers by partitioning them into tens and ones.

Adding and Subtracting with two digit numbers

Children will learn how to use column subtraction and addition.

Science

Everyday Materials

We will be learning about the properties of everyday materials and considering the pros and cons of their usage.

Animals including humans

We will be looking at the characteristics of living things, habitats, how we use our senses, similarities and differences between animals, healthy diets and the importance of exercise.
