Making a Tudors Portrait

Have a go at making portraits inspired by the Tudors! Your job is to draw yourself wearing fancy Tudor clothes like big collars, hats, and jewels. If you're not confident in drawing your face, you can stick a picture of your face on the paper and focus on creating the Tudor clothes and details around it! You can add fabric pieces for the clothes and stick on jewels to make the portrait 3D!
