The St. Osmund's PTFA is grateful for the continuous support of our families and wider Barnes community. Events, in particular events of this magnitude, could not happen without your assistance.

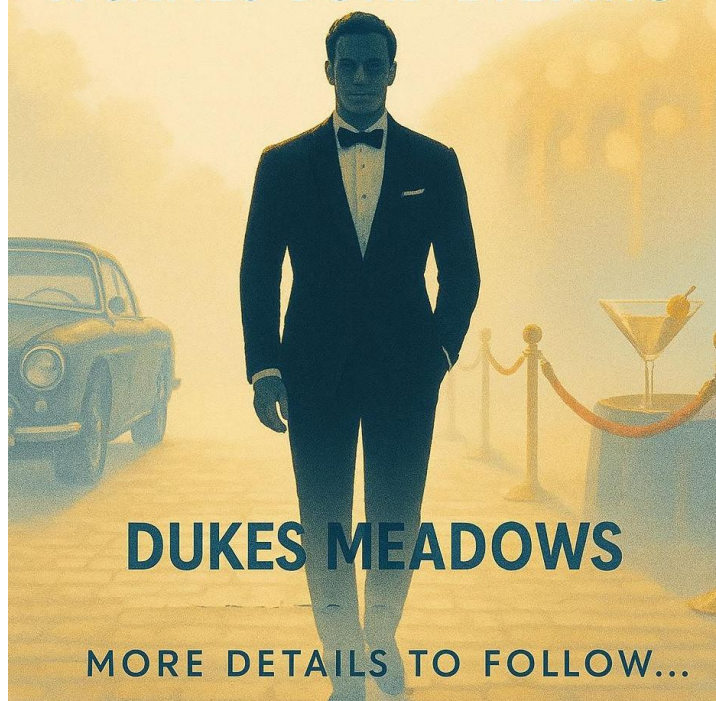
